Robert Moss is an expert trader, large volume order execution expert, and trading system developer with numerous accomplishments. An active problem solver and troubleshooter, Robert is able to develop winning teams and plans and lead operations to success. In addition to his trading experience that encompasses stocks, equities, futures, and options markets, with a focus on FX, equity indices, metals, grains, energies, and interest rates; Robert is also an inventor and patent-holder with thorough understanding of intellectual property and patent application processes. As a long-time consultant and floor trader, he possesses an extended network of business associates; including high-level executives, hedge funds, and private equity investors.

Robert was the President, Director and Majority Shareholder of RAM Management Group, Ltd., a CTA and CPO firm that offers clients a quantitative investment model that utilizes exchange traded, liquid, centrally cleared, transparent, daily marked-to-market futures contracts. In this position, Robert leveraged his decades of experience to trade in 30 different markets worldwide across seven various economic sectors. Robert served as the managing member of the RAM Fund LLC, a Delaware limited liability company. Robert founded RAM Management Group in 1992, after designing a macro-global investment model based on decades of direct market observations. He enlisted the help of a mathematics professor and statistics expert from Cornell University to develop the model further, leveraging statistical inference and pattern recognition functionalities.

Parallel to his work during the early years of RAM Management Group, Robert worked as Floor Broker for Mofran One, LLC and Dollar Index Services, where he established a brokerage operation with the NY Cotton Exchange and NY Coffee, Sugar, and Cocoa Exchange, before becoming the President of Mofran One to act as business consultant to numerous firms.

Earlier in his career, Robert served as the personal floor broker for legendary futures traders Richard Dennis and William Eckhardt, as well as representing C&D Commodities and the Dennis Trading Group, a CTA, and the legendary "Turtles," on all New York commodity exchanges at the World Trade Center, including N.Y. Cotton Exchange, the FINEX Exchange, the N.Y. Mercantile Exchange, the Commodity Exchange, Inc., and the N.Y. Coffee, Sugar and Cocoa Exchange, Inc. The firm generated more than \$300 million in profit during his tenure.

Robert started his career as an Independent Floor Trader in the futures markets, focusing on strength-weakness inter-intra-market spreading across FX, grains, metals, interest rates, energies, and stock indices before becoming the Senior Trader and Market-Maker for Mid-Am Options, Inc., where he managed floor trading operations owned by Richard Dennis,

focusing primarily on IBM, Xerox, Teledyne stocks, and the OEX Index, generating over \$10 million in profit for the company.

As a well-known and connected leader, Robert has been a member of a number of professional organizations and exchanges, which include the National Futures Association (NFA), the Chicago Board of Trade (CBOT), the Chicago Board Options Exchange (CBOE), the Mid-America Commodity Exchange, the N.Y. Mercantile Exchange (NYMEX), the N.Y. Commodity Exchange, Inc. (COMEX), the N.Y. Coffee, Sugar and Cocoa Exchange, Inc., the N.Y. Cotton Exchange and the FINEX Exchange.

He has been featured multiple times as one of the world's top traders in Futures Magazine's Top Traders list in 2005, 2007, 2008, 2010, and 2012.
